From my past messages

April 7, 2022

I think that recent President's proposals on ELFO's policy regarding conciliation presented to the GA (General Assembly) are also great, dynamic and very wonderful. Firstly, these proposals are more mutual, therefore far more realistic, secondly, they don't accelerate hatred of belligerents each other, rather they will mitigate people's distress, thirdly a way of efforts to establish peace by Song (Earth-Loving Flowers) and other Arts is surprisingly very significant means to unite all people around the world.

President's such initiative will accelerate the conciliatory activities of the ICCRUW (International Conciliation Commission on Russo-Ukrainian Way). At present time we must do something which we can ASAP, must not sit silently. Here I want to say 2 points.

- 1. Let's invite especially Russians and Ukrainians to sing the Earth-Loving Flowers together with people around the world!!
- 2. At the same time again and again I say that News and Communication Council make up a fair, neutral, and objective report, summing up both belligerents' opinions and objective facts because subjective and partial opinions are spreading, deepening gaps between nations.

Anyway I reconfirm my "Yes" vote concerning ELFO's policy posed by President. So, the members whom I represent (p.5~) will be regarded as having voted "Yes" if they don't vote "No". (ELFO Charter, Art.8)

Please CONSTRUCTIVE opinion rather than condemnation

I am glad that these days between belligerents negotiation goes on oftener concerning Russo-Ukrainian War, but sad that war victims are still increasing, and world people' hearts are becoming heavier under the double distress of war and coronavirus.

By all means compromise is necessary more or less between belligerents. Today I knew by TV that Ukrainian side may compromise, not joining NATO, but with condition of Ukrainian formula adopted.

Yesterday President Rikio announced 3 members of the ELACC (Earth-Loving Amicable Friendly Conciliation Commission), asking to recognize them, and to adopt Mr. Ajay Singh's STATEMEMT as ELFO Policy. I agree to these proposals.

And I am of firm opinion that even if belligerents wage war bitterly, our ELFO Members of these belligerent States as well as other countries should maintain friendship among us. It is possible that more and more Russians and Belorussians approve their Governments, at same time more people around the world support Ukrainian Government.

These opponent States and people will sharpen their attitude toward each other, on the other hand, how about the States who abstained from voting in the United Nations in March 3, 2022 ? (http://mopw.org/yes.no-unsc.pdf).

Anyway it is an urgent task to promote the ELACC (Earth-Loving Amicable Conciliation Committee) and the ICCRUW (International Conciliation Commission on Russo-Ukrainian War). Now ELFO President and Secretariat are extremely busy, working with no money. So please send us your more practical CONSTRACTIVE idea for cease-fire and restoration of peace rather than condemnation which may cause members' bad emotion, spending many times of vehement discussion, for elucidation of facts and law, beyond ability of the Secretariat.

I proposed already very practical CONSTRUCTIVE idea for cease fire, not condemning both of belligerents, which both of them, therefore, may be willing to agree to. Essence of my proposal is that belligerents shall stop firing, at least while negotiation is going on, later the term may be prolonged, for example, at the time of online negotiation or festival days. Personally I will help passionately such good idea man realize its concrete plan.

Let's create Conciliation Commission ASAP

I talked with ELFO President Rikio Kaneko about an ICCRUW (International Conciliation Commission for Russo-Ukrainian War). And I agreed to (1) his Urgent Motion that the ICCRUW be set up, and (2) my STATEMEMNT below-mentioned be also regarded as ELFO's policy.

I think that at the first stage it is better to organize the ICCRUW which is to be composed of Indian Government, Chinese Government and our ELFO. Let the ELFO propose its idea which both Governments may agree to soon, and which it possible that both belligerent Russian and Ukrainian Governments agree to. For example, firstly, how about simple proposal that while negotiation on cease-fire is to be held on a given day, belligerents should stop firing on.

Dear members, please send us constructive opinion rather than condemning bitterly each other, causing bad emotion. There are MANY MANY constructive steps to be taken.

My STATEMENT on Russo-Russian War

Dear Members of the Earth-Loving Friendly Organization, Dear Russian and Ukrainian people, and world people

ELFO Secretary HOPE Watanabe (March 11, 2022)

I was born in Ukraine, then lived in Russia, where my name is Nadejda, and married a Japanese Watanabe, so here my name 望美, which means 'hopeful beauty', ho, ho, ho, and so English name is HOPE Watanabe.

Secondly, LIFE is most valuable, therefore, belligerents should stop immediately war, and negotiate continuously, mitigating current situation, not strengthening military force.

Thirdly, compromise is necessary more or less from the both sides. I am glad to know a little bit compromise from Ukrainian side. If Russian Federation cannot concede neutralization and demilitarization of Ukraine, what good scheme or things can Russian Government offer for Ukraine?

Fifthly, apart from legal aspects of Russo-Ukrainian War, I think we must consider also Russian position more or less. When Cuban crisis happened, then US President stated clearly that he was ready to use nuclear weapon because nuclear base in Cuba was very dangerous to the United States of America. If Cuba had been ready to make her country neutral and demilitarized, would the USA have welcomed it? Undoubtedly the answer is "Yes" because it would have been far safer for the USA.

Sixly, in such urgent time as it is, ELFO's conciliatory action should begin with organizing its internal Commission, not stimulating belligerent bad emotion toward us.
