Charter of the ELFO (Earth-Loving Friendly Organization) stipulates as follows:

**Article 10 (effectuation)** Present Charter becomes effective in the following cases:

a.~c. (omission)

d. on the day after 1,000 individuals from among 30 States become a candidate for an ELFO member.

Our ELFO was established in accordance with the aforementioned Charter, Art., Paragraph d.

## Dip. of int'l organization belongs To Solidarity D. and Interstate D.

Though Diplomats of international organization will play thier proper roles in the SD (Silidarity Council), they will belong also to the Interstate the ID (Interstate Department).

The United Nations is organization where national interests are adjusted while our Earth-Loving Friendly Organization will defend not only national, but also all human being interests.

Its draft Charter, Article 8 reflects such principal idea. Not only States, but also autonomies and individual have due votes. The ELFO Charter provides:

Article 8 (The right to vote) 1 Members poll different votes in accordance with their kinds, in principle, as follows:

The number of votes is based on population of States, autonomies, members of organizations.

- **a.** a State and an autonomy (self-governing community) have bellow-mentioned right to vote, ratio of its population being taken into account;
  - i 80 votes are given to a State or autonomy with more than 1,000,000,000; (India, China)
  - ii 70 votes are given to a State or autonomy with the population from 100,000,000, 000 to less than 1,000,000,000; (*Philippine, Bangladesh, US, Indonesia, Pakistan, Russia, Japan*)

iii 60 votes are given to a State and an autonomy with the population from 10,000,000

from 10,000,000 to 100,000,000. (Algeria, Argentina, Cameroon, Iran, Sri Lank, Poland, Myanmar, Mexico, Ghana, Senegal, Nepal,)

iv 50 votes are given to a State and an autonomy with population from 1,000,000 to less than 10,000, 000; (Dominica, Israel, Lebanon, South Sudan, Benin, EL Salvador, Hamburg, Sapporo:bellow photo)

v 40 votes are given to a State and an autonomy with the population from 100,000 to less than 1,000,000;

vi 30 votes are given to a State and an autonomy with the population from 10,000 to less than 100,000; (Malta, Bhudiganga)

vii 20 votes are given to a State and an autonomy with the population from 1,000 to less than 10,000;

viii 10 votes are given to a State and an autonomy with the population less than 1,000.

### The UN and other regional organization 国際連合と他の国際組織

How many votes shall be given to international organizations? There are many kinds of organizations. Here I want to consider such international organizations members of which are States. At present time there is not a rule regarding it, but I will propose that votes are given to an international organization in accordance with the whole population living in these member states.

A draft Charter of the ELFO stipulates that 80 votes are given to a State or autonomy with more than 1,000,000,000; (as China & India). So 80 votes will be given to the United Nations.

### Article 15 on the Interstate Council

Above-shown all the VIPs have such special status as bellow-mentioned in Charter, Article 15:

Article 15 (Interstate Council) 1 In the provisional period, as for a State where a State Head is not a Councilor, former Heads of State, former candidates for a Head of State, present and former diplomats as well as members Solidarity Council may be a Councilor, and the Council may be opened only by these Councilors.

The present Article 15 is a new one which I made open to the public on May 6, 2019. Up to the present time I used words 'Interstate Council'. Because only God knows when a State joins this Council. So now I propose to open the wider door through which a former Head of State and former candidates for a Head of State and even diplomats

#### may also be a Councilor.

2 A former State Head has 30 % of votes which a present State Head may have. Each former candidate for a Head of State has 20 % of votes which a present State Head may have.

This is a stipulation which reflects multilateral opinions and interests in a given country, and makes closer connections with world people fairly.

Dr. Leo Rebello was a candidate for Indian President of 2017, and joined our ELA on March, 19, 2020. If he is to be a member of the Council, he would have 16 votes. (clik here)

3. The present Council shall be composed of 20 Councilors with different nationality, and President will respect a list of candidates for a Councilor which a plenary meeting of a Department of the Council recommends.

# Who will be Representative of this Department?

At present time there are more than 50 members in the Department of the Interstate Council. 20 Councilors will be selected from among them. Who is ready to be a Councilor?

In future there will be many ELA-Diplomats in our ELFO, Then what will do the other diplomats? The members other than Councilors have their own functions, too, See the following paragraph:

4. A diplomat may be a member or an observer of other principal organs excepting a News and Information Council, the Earth-Loving Amicable Court and Secretariat.

The latter 3 organs don't want intervention from Sates. But other 21 Councils will welcome ELA-Diplomats and other VIPs.

At the first stage of development of the Council let's try to do a simple and easy plan. Then gradually we'll do something more important.

6. Under the present Council will be set up an office which is composed of retired diplomats mainly, provided that it has its own right to propose.
