Agenda item 1. Ideals to be considered in 2023 year

1. Mr. Ajay Singh, 3rd President sent his article to important staffs of the ELFO, which may be one of the aforementioned ideals. See his article: <http://mopw.org/ajay's%20ideal%20to11ga.pdf>

Then, Hon.Pres. Rikio Kaneko requested him to explain the term “UN-SDG 4.7” and “UN-SDG16.a”. He answered, among others, as follow (Italic) :

Lots of thank for the question, following your suggestion, I am explaining about the “UN-SDG 4.7”and “UN-SDG16.a” for Hon. Hon. Pres. Mr. Rikio Kaneko and and all.Solidarity and Peace! Great Idea! Sounds good! But do we have any idea to strengthen the basis for peace and solidarity in actual fact?

In fact, it had been always lethal to write or address straightaway in favor or against the institutionalized faith of human being divided by several political and religious strictures. So to strengthen the basis for peace and solidarity is a most complicated challenge for all of those who seek to make this planet safe for all by revealing the sources of unity and trust for each other.

Presently at the forefront the global community is baffled by the means to prevent the global warming (climate change) and the effects of COVID 19. On other hand the global leadership is rapidly developing the weapons for mass destruction that would destroy this planet more than our imagination. Rather than paying attention for the betterment of all humanity, they are dedicated for making policies to advance their own sovereignty beyond the basis for humanity and peace and as a thrall of egoism.

Within these worst circumstances; what do we mean by peace and solidarity?

Such complicated question confront the world’s leadership and all leading religious instructors who thirst for a unanimous conclusion for global security in the current predicament of nuclear proliferation, terrorism and war, within the context of the moral crisis in political ethics that dedicated to obtain prosperity, leaving behind the issues of humanitarian crisis worldwide.

Unfortunately today we can see how the global leadership is navigating the entire human race to an unnatural end, only to grab a part of land or to strengthen their mortal sovereignty. It means, they are not a real leader of people and they do not have any idea to strengthen the basis for solidarity and peace or the values of their political and professional needs are much higher than what we do need to make this planet a safe place for all.

How can we ignore the true facts that forcing the entire human race to a grave risk? We can see how the effects of climate change in the current predicament of Nuclear proliferation, terrorism and war is leading the entire world towards an unnatural end. Thus without strengthening the basis for peace and solidarity, any attempts to solve all issues relating to poverty, global warming and other humanitarian crisis constitutes a political business in actual fact.

Now many organizations and the United Nations as well are unanimously advocating to strengthen the basis for peace and solidarity and even all the member state of UN had unanimously adopted the SDGs for the betterment of all humanity worldwide, but due to lack of a strategy for an integrated action, their efforts are still beyond the path to the success of SDGs.

Here what we propose is the blueprint of a simple action to redefine the human conscience (following the core value of SDG 4.7 and SDG 16.a); to bridge up the gaps between all cultures, norms and mores, without disgracing the belief of any humankind and as we do need to unite the global community beyond their inherited system of thoughts.

There is no doubt, all the 17 Goals and its 169 associated targets are interlinked and designed for the betterment of all humanity, but our responses to achieve the goals are fragmented and till now we are nowhere near a unanimous conclusion for an integrated action to achieve the goals by time.

We mean, to achieve the SDGs by time, let us implement the goals step by step and according to the need of this contemporary world. In fact, there can be no sustainable development without peace and no peace without sustainable developments.

Furthermore by strengthening the basis for global peace, the global leadership can easily reduce the cost for developing the weapons for mass destruction to maintain the costs to achieve the SDGs. So

first of all we will have to pay devout attention to achieve the SDG 4.7 targeting the SDG 16.a.

(SDG 4.7 is determined to ensure all learners acquire knowledge and skills needed to promote sustainable development, including among other through education for SD and sustainable life, human right, gender equality, promotion of a culture of peace and non-violence, global citizenship and of culture's contribution to SDGs.)

Presently our academia, institutions and governing bodies are dedicated only to tackle the embodiment of the problems; ignoring its negative aspects that increasing day by day as a complicated challenge before the entire world. We mean within the impacts of globalization and rapid technical change, today we can see how inequality raises economic anxiety and undermines social cohesion, human rights and peace.

Within these circumstances, education based on the core values of SDG 4.7 is the best instrument to redefine the contemporary political and professional tools that we do need for an integrated action to achieve the 2030 Agenda. SDG 4.7 deeply holds the basic ideology to guide the global community to adopt the SDG 16.a in one notion, for the promotion of peace and non-violence and appreciation of cultures contribution to sustainable developments. In fact, without peace and global unity, it is impossible for the world's leadership to pay devout attention for the success of SDGs by time.

I mean, we can easily implement the SDG 4.7 without any cost or extra effort targeting the SDG 16.a as the basic strategy to achieve the 2030 Agenda..

(The full text of Target 16.a: "Strengthen relevant national institutions, including through international cooperation, for building capacity at all levels, in particular in developing countries, to prevent violence and combat terrorism and crime. "It has one indicator "Existence of independent national human rights institutions in compliance with the Paris Principles".)

Here what we propose to expand the SDG 4.7 targeting the SDG 16.a; is a basic ideology to Strengthen all relevant national institutions, including international cooperation, for building capacity at all levels, to prevent violence and combat terrorism and crime and to develop friendly relations among nations based on the respect for the principal of equal rights and self determination of people as we

do need to take appropriate measures to strengthen the basis for global peace.

Straightaway it is impossible for any academia, institutions and governing bodies to establish a just and lasting peaceful order in the world. So first of all we will have to represent the ideology of SDG 4.7 as the first step towards the success of SDGs.

Till now, the global powers are only destroying the embodiment of terrorism, ignoring its brutal ideology that is still invincible before the entire world. That means, the world leadership is not interested to eliminate the root cause of terrorism and racism that is being used as a political tool for professional beneficence.

We all are well aware of the true fact: "There can be no sustainable development without peace and no peace without sustainable developments." So we are advocating to advance the SDG 4.7 at our academia, institutions and governing bodies, for the promotion of peace and non-violence and appreciation of cultures contribution to sustainable developments, as we do need to bridge up the gaps between all cultures, norms and mores without disgracing the belief of any humankind, targeting the core value of SDG 16.a that determined to prevent violence and combat terrorism and racism at grass root level.

Here we mean, it's the time for action, not for beautiful speeches and empty promises for political use. Humanity must be saved from both the horror of terrorism and the panic of counter terrorism warfare. Although the words expressing our religious belief may be different, but the meaning is the same for everyone and that is: without peace and solidarity, it is impossible to obtain the graces of SDGs as we do need to make this planet safe for our future generation.

As there was no objection to the 3rd President Ajay Singh's proposal on Ideals to be considered in 2023, today (FEB 21, 2023) I decide that it was adopted unanimously by the ELFO GA.

Congratulation, Mr. Ajay Singh, on adoption of your proposal!!

Higher than Everest

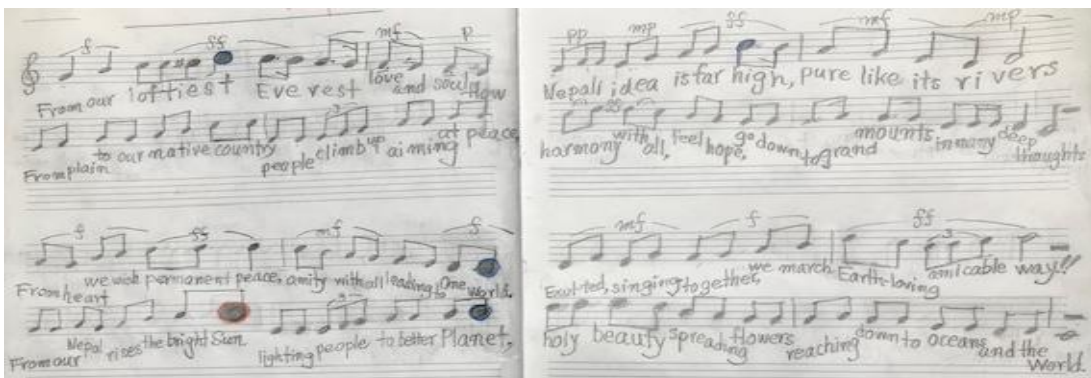

Agenda item 3. Disarmament, especially nuclear (ended)

1. To advance our proposed disarmament agenda, first of all what we need is global unity at grass roots by bridging up the gaps between all cultures, norms and mores without disgracing the faith of any humankind. *(Presently we all are rapidly moving up to an unnatural end, under the shadow of NUCLEAR WEAPONS, within the context of worldwide moral crisis in political ethics.*

2. Act local – Think global! *(At the forefront the global community is baffled by means prevent global warming, pandemics and other humanitarian crisis. On other hand our great leadership are rapidly developing and using the weapons for mass destruction, which might destroy this planet forever.)*

3. Agenda item 4. Simplified Election of President of an ELFA(ended)

Regarding a candidate for President of national ELFA (Earth-Loving-Friendly Association), Hon. Pres. Rikio Kaneko proposed simplified procedure, which the GA adopted. It reads as follows:

Where national ELFA is not established, a member may be President of that ELFA, provided the following conditions shall be satisfied.

- a. the member will send to the ELFO GA one's determination (political opinion) to be President of a national ELFA.
- b. no rival candidate appears within 10 days after the notification, by the GA Chair, of the 1st candidate's above determination to GA members.
- c. The GA shall decide procedure when more than 2 candidates appear.

Today (March 20, 2023) further, Hon.Pres.Rikio proposed to annex this procedure to the Rules on Presidents and their concerned staffs. (See an attach.)

You know, currently there are several national ELFA (Earth-Loving Friendly Association). namely, **Mexican (MELFA), Fijian (FELFA), Nepali (NELFA), Indian (IELFA), Japanese (JELFA), Brazilian (BELFA)**. Fortunately several candidates for President of national ELFA appeared.

Regarding election of Presidents Hon. Pres. Rikio Kaneko asks the GA to adopt, among others, his following proposal as these candidates were already introduced for some weeks by messages and in web site to ELFO members. He proposes 5 points:

1. **Strengthening GA's competence.** Existing rule on GA's competence is simple: Rules on Presidents and their concerning staffs, Article 37 stipulates that "GA's decision is prior to CEAC's." (Central Election Administration Committee) (<http://mopw.org/rules%20on%20presidents%20230204.pdf>) Hon. Pres. proposes a clause to be added to the said rule. So that Article 37 will be as follows:

Article 37. GA's decision is prior to CEAC's. The GA may conduct election of President of national Earth-Loving Friendly Association without organizing CEAC, provided that ELFO GA shall respect, first of all, wish of a given national ELFA's wish.

2. **Liberia.** Election will be conducted in Liberia with 2 candidates Mr. [Hilary B. Davies](#) and Mr. [Samson Sehgren](#).
3. Ex. Amb. [Saula Sovanivalu](#) from Fiji; [Amb Emmanuel Lavalie](#) from Sierra Leone; [Amb. BUGINGO Annanie](#) from Rwanda; [Amb. Bachir NIANG SO](#) from Central Africa will be President of their national ELFA if a rival candidate does not appear by **March 25, 2023**.
4. This time election will be conducted in accordance with aforesaid Article 37, and the GA Chair will be responsible for administration of all the election above-mentioned.

Hon.Pres. Rikio Kaneko proposed to the 11th GA to adopt his Rules, which the GA did. In March 11, 2023 he proposed an additional clause (see Art.2, parag.2) and AJTAC's first activity of treating with border conflict between India and Nepal. (See see at the end of this agenda item) which also the GA adopted. Today (in March 16, 2023) further he presented additional phrase to the same parag.2, rosy phrase)

A. Border Conflict Between India and Nepal

The Rules of One Judge Territorial Amicable Court

On 20th day of February, 2023 year General Assembly of our Earth-Loving Friendly Organization (hereinafter referred to as ELFO),
Attaching importance to establishing Earth community ruled by law,
Considering that there were some territorial cases which only one Judge decided,
Cooperating with our friendly International Conciliation Organization (hereinafter referred to as ICO)
Decided to adopt the following system of One Judge Territorial Amicable Court (hereinafter referred to as OJTAC or Court)

Article 1. The OJTAC uses the Internet as much as possible, and shall contribute to development of digital lawsuit.

Article 2. The Judge (named also President) and Registrar shall be recognized by the ELFO General Assembly (GA), and when engaged on the business of the Court, shall enjoy diplomatic privileges and immunities in contesting States.

2. When President gets into difficulties and cannot engage on the business of the Court, the GA shall elect immediately a new President from among an ELFO Commission of International Law with a majority vote of nine tenth. If the majority vote does not reach the aforesaid level, a contesting party may withdraw from the Court.

Article 3. The seat of the Court shall be established at a place where President resides. This, however, shall not prevent the Court from sitting and exercising its functions elsewhere whenever the Court considers it desirable.

Article 4. The Court will consider
a. Treaty
b. Governmental agreements between conflicting parties
c. international custom, as evidence of a general practice accepted as law;
d. judicial decisions and the teachings of the most highly qualified publicists of the various nations, as subsidiary means for the determination of rules of law.
2. This provision shall not prejudice the power of the Court to decide a case *ex aequo et bono*.

Article 5. The official languages of the Court shall be English.

Article 6. Cases are brought before the Court by the notification of the special agreement (compromise) to the President of the Court. In the case the subject of the dispute and the parties

shall be indicated.

Article 7. The Court shall have the power to indicate, if it considers that circumstances so require, any provisional measures which ought to be taken to preserve the respective rights of either party.

Article 8. The procedure shall consist of two parts: written and oral, provided that oral procedure shall be conducted by video.

Article 9. The hearing in Court shall be public on the Internet, unless the parties demand that the public be not admitted.

Article 10. Whenever one of the parties does not appear before the Court, or fails to defend its case, the other party may call upon the Court to decide in favor of its claim.

Article 11. The judgment shall state the reasons on which it is based.

Article 12. President's 1st draft award shall be sent to ICO Consulting Commission and to ELFO Commission of International Law for hearing **their** opinions, provided that a national of contesting parties shall not be a member of these 2 Commissions.

Article 13. President shall continue considering qualification of the draft award so long as more than one fifth (1/5) members of the aforementioned 2 Commissions are against it.

Article 14. President's qualified draft award shall be submitted to both ELFO General Assembly (GA) and ICO GA for hearing their opinions, provided that a national of contesting parties shall not be a member of these GAs.

Article 15. Considering opinions of these 2 GAs, President of the Court shall send the final award to the contesting States.

Article 16. The judgment is final and without appeal. In the event of dispute as to the meaning or scope of the judgment, the Court shall construe it upon the request of any party.

Article 17. Judicial costs depend upon an agreement among the President and parties to the dispute, provided that unless otherwise decided by the Court, each contesting party shall bear its own costs. The OJTAC shall be based on the self-supporting system, so the ELFO will not be financially responsible for the OJTAC.

2. Contesting States shall pay remuneration to their Registrars respectively.

Article 18. A jurist of international law or President of the Court may be a Registrar of the Court. Both Contesting States may appoint a Deputy-Registrar from among her public service personnel.

Article 19. A Deputy-Registrar may be removed from office if, in President's opinion, the incumbent has either become permanently incapacitated from exercising his or her functions, or has committed a breach of duty.

Article 20. The Court may give an advisory opinion on any territorial legal question at the request of contesting States. In the exercise of its advisory functions the Court shall further be guided by the provisions of the present Rules with necessary qualifications.

I, Rikio Kaneko (Ho.Prof. Sapporo University) was recognized by the GA as the President of the OJTAC.

B. Border Conflict Between India and Nepal

There are so many territorial problems in the world. And our ELFO FAMILY has contribute to settling some of them: issuance Renaissance dam problem; Palestinian problem; Territorial problems between Russia and Ukraine.

This time Hon. Pres. Rikio Kaneko proposed to the GA that ELFO FAMILY would pay attention to border conflict between India and Nepal. You can see the outline of the conflict in his attachment. Gist of our contribution to the matter is as follows (The GA adopted it later):

I . Notification by the ICO of its readiness to Conciliation

Our ICO and the ELFO will propose to Indian and Nepali Governments to try to settle their border conflict not only by negotiation, but also by other peaceful means provided for in UN Charter, Aericle 33. If both conflictiong Sates wants our ICO to conciliate between them, we will do it with pleasure.

II . ELFO's readiness to let the OJTAC function

When it becomes clear that both conflicting parties or one of them is not ready to submit it its border conflicts to peaceful means other than negotiation, then our ELFO GA will deliberate this matter and propose settlement by the OJTAC to Indian and Nepali Governments.

III. ICO Consulting Commission

President's 1st draft award shall be sent to ICO Consulting Commission and to ELFO Commission of International Law for hearing **their** opinions, provided that a national of contesting parties shall not be a member of these 2 Commissions. (Rules of the OJTAC, Art.12.)
