President Proposal:

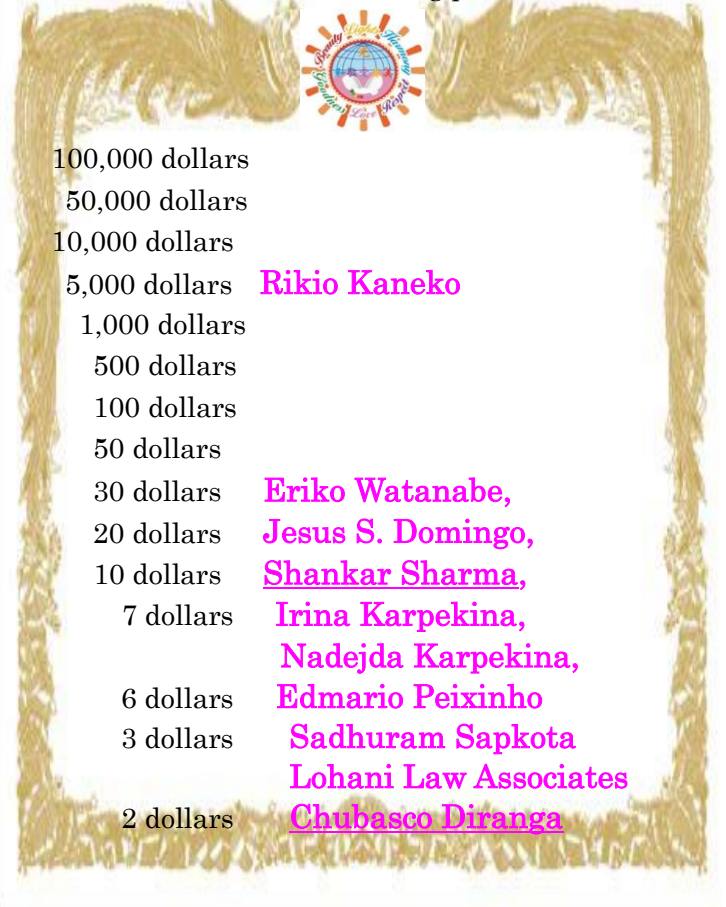
The last part of the Charter will be as follows:

Article 100 (Location and Authentic text) 1. The General Assembly shall determine every 25 years the location of the headquarters of the Organization.

1. In the present Organization for 25 years the English and Japanese texts are equally authentic, and the Chinese, French, Russian, Spanish and Arabian texts are subsidiary.

An additional clause on donation

Bellow-mentioned List of **Donation** is an indivisible part of the present Charter. Donors' names shall be carved in the **present** Charter and **ELFO** archives, thereafter being praised forever.

Thus I propose to the GA that the President may add donator's name to its list without recognition by the GA though "an additional clause on donation" is "an indivisible part" of the Charter.

At any time any donator may contribute more money than the original donation.

Honorable Member

I also propose to the GA that the members, who has paid 5 years membership fee in advance, would be praised as an honorable member of the ELFO, provided that other kinds of Hon. Member may be created. (DEC 27,2021)

Any member having contributed considerably to the development of the ELFO, even if has not paid 5 years membership fee in advance, may also be recognized as an Honorable member.

Agenda item N.2. Commissions of the Deputies D.

The Deputies Council is composed in all 26 Deputies, while the DD (Department of Deputies) will consist of numerous Parliamentarians and other deputies from many countries around the world. And it will be necessary to create many committees as provided for in Article 44. I propose to set up the following Commissions corresponding to a Principal organ of the ELFO:

Dear VIPs and Diplomats

An organizational problem

Hopefully you and your family are fine. I am very pleased that day after day a new Diplomat joins our ELFO, and all of them seem to understand the very important and historical roles of the Interstate Council (IC).

There are so many VIPs and Diplomats (more than 150 persons) in the IC that an organizational problem emerged.

According to the ELFO Charter, 'The present Council shall be composed of 20 Councilors with different nationality, and President will respect a list of candidates for a Councilor which a plenary meeting of a Department of the Council recommends.' (Article 15) Now in order to meet new situation I propose 3 points to you:

1. Strengthening of the IC.

At the beginning of the IC I appointed Diplomats as a Councilor irrespective their passion. At present there may be more passionate Diplomats ready to work seriously, so a Councilor who is too busy to perform one's role in the IC may be freed from the post.

And I want passionate diplomats recommend oneself as a Councilor within 20 members frame.

2. Creation of functional commissions

At present time there is neither any commission nor other subsidiary organ under the IC or the ID (Interstate Department of more than 150 members).

But, you know, many of VIPs and Diplomats belong at the same time, to other Councils or and their Departments.

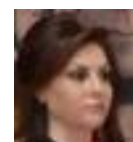

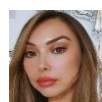
